Target: Take Charge of Education Program

Target will donate 1% of purchases to Saint Joseph School when you use your rewards card (REDcard) at their retail and online stores.

Important: You must specifically choose a school for the program to take effect.

1. Enrolling is easy when you have a REDcard. Just choose an eligible K-12 school.
2. Go to target.com/tcoe
3. Select "Enroll Now:Find a School".
4. Search "School ID" using *8195* for Saint Joseph School and proceed with the school designation process.
5. When you use your rewards card, donations total 1% of your purchases at Target and Target.com and 1/2% of Target Visa Credit Card purchases made everywhere Visa credit cards are accepted.
6. Checks are sent twice a year in March and September to the school.
