2020-2021 Influenza Vaccination Deadline Removed

The Massachusetts Department of Public Health has **removed the requirement for flu vaccination for attendance in childcare/ preschool, primary, secondary and postsecondary education.** Preliminary data show that this has been a mild flu season to date, presumably as people have received their seasonal flu vaccine and have been adhering to mask-wearing and social distancing due to COVID-19.

Given the intensive Commonwealth-wide efforts regarding COVID-19 vaccination, DPH wants to alleviate the burden to obtain flu vaccination and focus on continuing our COVID -19 vaccination efforts.

DPH continues to strongly recommend that everyone age six months and older receive their seasonal flu vaccine each year.

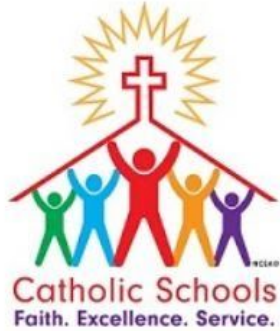
